Overnight security will be provided.

1. This contract is void if it is not signed and received by July 1st, 2009.
2. Set-up may begin at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday August 20th. Exhibitors supply own table/awnings. Please have all merchandise set up by 3:00 p.m. or space may be resold.
3. Exhibitors unload, set-up, and park at the direction of event coordinators.
4. Exhibitors will not remove their displays prior to 6:00p.m on August 22nd.
5. Exhibitors will remove all trash, papers, boxes, etc. from their space.
6. Exhibitors will not sell alcoholic beverages, firearms, and illegal or emitting items.
7. Exhibitors will not hook up to electrical outlets without permission.
8. Exhibitors will truthfully represent all items (reproductions, 2nds, etc.).
9. Exhibitors will cooperate fully with all requests of event coordinators.
10. Definition: Exhibitor means "person signing this contract and/or anyone accompanying him/her or doing business using his/her space".
11. Event Organizers or City of Eureka will not be held liable for any losses, damages, or injuries sustained by exhibitors in any manner whatsoever.

13. All booths serving food must comply with the County health codes.
